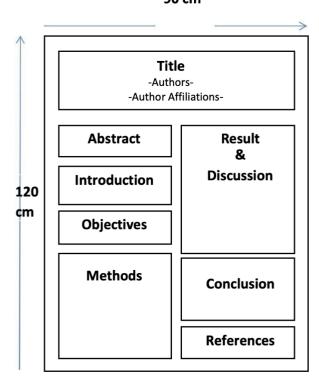
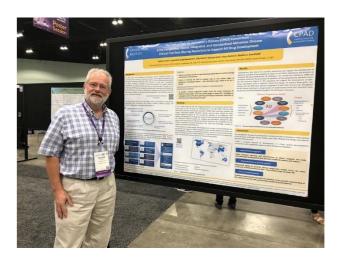
Poster Guidelines for Submission and Display (IRSM 2023)

The IRSM 2023 organizing committee invites poster submission from original research works on or before **15th August 2023**. The posters must be formatted and structured in accordance with the following guidelines.

- 1. The size of each poster should be 120 cm high and 90 cm wide. [2 cm margin from each side should be reserved.
- 2. The orientation of the poster must be in portrait style.
- 3. The title of the study, names of the authors (s), and their affiliations should be displayed at the top of the poster.
 - a. Characters of the title should be a minimum of 72-point (3 cm) font size and author(s) and their affiliations should be at least 48-point (2 cm).
- 4. The poster should include an Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Method, Results and Discussion, Conclusion/s, and Acknowledgment/s (if any).
- 5. The text and illustrations of the poster should be readable from about 1 m distance.
- 6. The information that your poster contains should be presented in a logical and selfexplanatory sequence.
- 7. The poster should be mounted on the poster display board at 8.30 a.m. on the day of the Research Symposium (November 16th, 2023). The author should be in attendance during the poster session. Display boards and facilities for mounting posters on the boards will be provided.
- 8. Your poster will be evaluated on technical content, organization of work, and visual impact by a panel of judges.
- Please note that QR codes or bar codes are not permitted on posters displayed at IRSM 2023 or on electronic versions of the posters.
- The softcopy of the poster should be submitted to <u>rajarata.irsm2023@gmail.com</u> as a Microsoft Word (doc/docx.) file or Microsoft PowerPoint (ppt) file on or before the deadline.
